An Order in Council¹, made on the 28th October 1664 by Charles II, saw the birth of the 'Marines' as *The Duke of York and Albany's Maritime Regiment of Foot*. They soon became known as the *Admiral's Regiment*, "to be distributed into His Majesty's Fleets prepared for Sea Service. The Evolution of the force is detailed below;

The divisional structure forming the Royal Marines is very important in terms of understanding the service life of an individual marine and a speculative search may prove extremely time consuming. Before embarking on such a search, consider the following;

Service Numbers

Service numbers in the Marines commence with a two-letter abbreviation of the marine's division;

- CH Chatham Division
- PL Plymouth Division
- PO Portsmouth Division
- RMA Royal Marine Artillery
- WO Woolwich Division

(CH, PO, PL). Service numbers were recorded on all kinds of personal possessions; button-guards, polishing brushes, medals, clothing and letters being just a few examples.

Medals and Awards

Referring to the roll of Royal Marines who received service or campaign medals will provide a service number and division.

Muster Rolls

Prior to 1947, HM Ships Royal Marine Detachments were drawn from the Royal Marines Division of the ship's home port. If you know the name of a ship and the date they were on-board, the Navy List for the relevant year will usually reveal the required information.

Catchment Areas

In most cases, Marines would join the Division for the area in which they were resident. Check the marine's location in census, birth and marriage records as this may provide the clue which leads to their service division.

Attestations	<p>These are the forms completed on enlistment and contain details of birthplace, occupation, physical description, dates of service and sometimes a detail of next of kin.</p> <p>Attestations are filed by division, and either by date of enlistment or by date of discharge. Courts martial	<p>Records of courts martial can be found in the main Admiralty correspondence in ADM 1, referenced by the indexes and digests in ADM 12.</p> <p>For the period from 1755 to 1806 alphabetical analyses and indexes may be found in ADM 12/21-28.</p> <p>Records of courts martial from 1911 to 1954 are in series ADM 156, some of which are not yet open to public inspection.</p>
Description Books	Several different types of register giving personal details are held in ADM 158. They were drawn up using information from the attestation papers, some of which no longer exist. They give date and place of enlistment, age, birthplace, occupation, physical description and details of promotions and whether injured or killed. The records are arranged within the divisions by company, then by letter of surname but are not strictly alphabetical.
Half Pay Lists (Officers)	Lists of officers on half pay can be found in ADM 6/410-414.
Leave Books (Officers)	Leave books for Royal Marine officers for the period from 1804 to 1846 are in ADM 6/200-206 and 414.
Medals	<p>Awards of medals to officers and other ranks are held in the naval medal series ADM 171.</p> <p>Long Service and Good Conduct Medals awarded between 1849 and 1894 are in ADM 201/21.</p> <p>Lists of the recipients of the Conspicuous Gallantry Medal, instituted for the Crimean War (1854-1856), can be found in the <i>Navy List</i> and in Admiralty Orders in ADM 182.</p> <p>There are medal rolls for 1914 to 1918 in ADM 171/75 and 1914 to 1929 in ADM 171/61.</p> <p>There is a medal roll for 1942 to 1972 in ADM 171/164-165.</p> <p>Distinguished Service Medal awards are indexed in ADM 171/75 for 1914-1918. Rolls for 1942 to 1972 are in ADM 171/164-165.</p> <p>Distinguished Service Order awards between 1886 and 1945 can be found in WO 390.</p> <p>Details of gallantry awards are published in the <i>London Gazette</i> in series ZJ 1.</p> <p>http://www.gazettes-online.co.uk/</p> <p>Names of the recipients of the Distinguished Service Cross (known as the Conspicuous Service Cross before 1914) appear in the <i>London Gazette</i> from 1901 but no citations have survived.</p> <p>Victoria Cross awards can be located on this database and full citations appear in the <i>London Gazette</i> (series ZJ 1),</p> <p>www.victoriacross.net/default.asp</p>

Muster Rolls	<p>Effective and Subsistence Books are held in ADM 96/117-461. They cover various periods, 1688 to 1714, 1739 to 1755, 1758 to 1763 and 1772 to 1835.</p> <p>A few colonial stations exist in ADM 96/462-468 for various dates from 1803 to 1834.</p> <p>Ships' musters, held in ADM 36/37, will include complements of marines on board ship.</p>
Officers	<p>No original records of service for officers survive before 1793. However, some details of service can be found by consulting the Seniority List of Officers from 1757 to 1886 in ADM 118/230-336 covering 1757 to 1770 and ADM 192/1-44 covering 1760 to 1886.</p> <p>Army Lists from 1740 list marine officers on full and half pay.</p> <p>The New Navy List from 1840 lists marine officers with short statements of service from 1846, some of which contain details going back to the 1790s.</p> <p>Commission and appointment books for 1703 to 1713 are in ADM 6/405 and for 1755 to 1814 in ADM 6/406. They are in date order, but are not indexed. They do not contain any genealogical information.</p> <p>The Admiralty conducted two surveys, one in 1822 and one in 1831. The survey of 1822, found in ADM 6/73-83 and 409, gives name, rank, date of seniority, age on 1 April 1822, amount of pay and whether in receipt of other allowances. A further survey was carried out in 1831 and returns are in ADM 6/84-85.</p> <p>Records of commissioned officers after 1793 can be found in ADM 196/58-65, 83, and 97-112. These give details of service, but are only complete from around 1837. ADM 313/110 is an index to these pieces, except 106-112, which have their own indexes.</p> <p>Registers of warrant officers appointed between 1875 and 1920 are in ADM 196/34-35, 67 and 102, indexed by ADM 313/110.</p> <p>For officers commissioned after 1925 you should write to the Historical Records Office Royal Marines.</p>
Pensions	<p>If a marine or warrant officer received a pension he may be found in Officers' and Ratings' Service Records, ADM 29 (Series II). These records include the name, place of birth, age on entry to the corps, rank, dates of entry and discharge from each ship served on, and total time served.</p> <p>They cover the period from 1802 to 1894 and are can be searched online at;</p> <p>www.nationalarchives.gov.uk/catalogue/default.asp?j=1</p> <p>The following records may also provide additional information of value to family historians;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ADM 166 Registers of pensions for marines from 1882. • PMG 72 Widows' pensions from 1921 to 1926. • DM 166 Pensions paid to the children of other ranks.
Pensions (Officers)	<p>Two alphabetical registers of officers in receipt of Greenwich pensions between 1862 and 1908 are in ADM 201/22-23.</p> <p>Registers of pensions from 1871 can be found in ADM 165.</p> <p>Records of officers' retired pay from 1871 to 1923 are in ADM 22/475-487.</p>
Subsistence Books (Officers)	<p>Officers' Subsistence Books, and Commission and Subsistence Books can be found in ADM 96/482-505, covering dates from 1757 to 1826.</p>
Widows' Pensions	<p>Widow's Pensions can be found in ADM 96/523 for 1712 to 1831.</p>

Wills

Wills of marines were deposited with the Navy Pay Office from 1786 to 1882 and are in ADM 48, indexed in ADM 142. Some earlier wills and letters of administration from 1740 to 1764 are in ADM 96/524.
