INTRODUCTION

The originals of these registers are now deposited in the Public Record Office, Kew, under the references RG4 and RG6. The registers were taken into the custody of the Registrar-General under the Non-Parochial Registers Act of 1840. They had previously been inspected and authenticated by a Royal Commission appointed "to enquire into the state, custody and authenticity of registers kept in churches and chapels other than those of the Established Church".

Full copies have been purchased on microfilm by the Archives and Records Service as part of its policy of making available locally major sources from elsewhere in the country. This enables them to be used with original non-Anglican records already held by the Service at Beverley. All such holdings are listed in the Handlist of Non-Anglican Records.

The area covered by these filmed registers is that of the former East Riding (including Hull) together with those parts of the former West Riding now in the present East Riding and those parts of the former North Riding within the Anglican Archdeaconry of the East Riding (the parish registers for which are already deposited in the Office). The North Riding border town of Malton is also included as East Riding members are amongst its chapel congregations. There are also four out-county "strays" (an unidentified one between Bradford and Halifax, Pontefract, Leeds and Beverley near Ripon) which were not ordered but are on the films as received.

Foundation dates and other historical details given in the handlist entries are taken in the main from the certificates or statements accompanying the registers when returned.

References for use

All films are under the Archives and Records Service reference Mf 2. The number in the left hand column of the entries is the sub-number of each film. The number in square brackets is the PRO reference and appears on each frame of the microfilm [most have the prefix RG 4, but those on films MF 2/1, 2 & 8 have the prefix RG 6, and the last register on MF2/10 has the prefix RG 8].
