Consumer Protection (Distance Selling) Regulations 2000

Payment of a refund will be made by the Society within 30 days of receipt of the returned goods in a re-saleable condition. A charge of £1 per order for postage and other costs incurred by the Society will be deducted from the refund. Refunds will be made by cheque.

No refunds will be made in respect of CD-ROMs or disks where the customer has broken open the seal or wrapper. If the Society has been asked to supply a service for a fee, then once the request and the fee for the service have been received by the Society, it will start to process the request and no 'cooling off period' shall apply, with the consequence that no refund of fee shall be made even if the customer wishes to stop the research.
